## **New Business**

### ***Hyzer Pines Closed***

SPRD is SERIOUSLY considering closing the course in Sisters due to rules violations, specifically smoking and drinking.

As a club, we need to set a positive example by following the rules ourselves and helping to enforce them. This course is on school property, and therefore can not have drinking, smoking and drug use associated with disc golf at this location.

We have schedule a meeting with SPRD Board on August 17 at 5 PM at the Coffield Center next to the course. If we want to course to continue, we need to present an action plan on how to curb the rules violations occurring at the course.

### **IDEAS:**

- Increase enforcement
  - Draft letter to police department, Sisters School Board and SPRD asking for increased patrol of the course with issued tickets to offenders
- Increase signage
- Require player check-in or Disc Golf parking pass or other 'fee per round'
  - Violators would be trespassing
- Club members will be required to sign a "Rules of Conduct" agreement stating that they will follow the rules.
- Club members need to set an example by following the rules and help enforce them
- Encourage offenders to play elsewhere/ offer additional venues

Other issues for board meeting:

- Restrooms
- Trash/ recycling
- Signage
- Course funds
- Partnership agreement

### ***COCC Closed***

These are the same issues we are fighting at Hyzer Pines. We need to address the smoking/ drinking policy at all area courses and make sure the rules are clearly posted. We need to schedule a meeting with COCC to address these concerns and help resolve these issues.

### ***Conclusion:***

Central Oregon Disc Golf Club members should promote disc golf as a healthy, lifetime fitness opportunity. There may be a place alcohol and smoking in disc golf, but it is not at a school. We are looking for positive role models as club members.
